## **RASFF Window**

The Commission publishes a searchable online database of RASFF notifications classified as alert, information notification or border rejection as part of its RASFF Portal. As it is necessary to strike the balance between openness and the Ine Commission publishes a searchable online database or IAASFF notifications classified as a lent, information not force rejection as part of its IAASFF Portal.
