## **RASFF Window**

The Commission publishes a searchable online database of RASFF notifications classified as alert, information notification or border rejection as part of its RASFF Portal. As it is necessary to strike the balance between openness and the Ine Commission publishes a searchable online database or IASFF notifications classified as a left, information not force rejection as part of its IASFF Portal. As it is necessary to strike the balance between openness and the identity of individual companies are not published. In the event that further information received from a contact point regarding an already published notification leads to modification or withdrawal of the notification, the Commission shall correct the information in its RASFF portal database at once or shall withdraw the notification concerned.
